Tour of Heritage Churches on the South Shore

There will be a Tour of Heritage Churches on the South Shore on Saturday, August 25. In the 1800's, hundreds of small churches sprang up all over the Island. Each one played a vital role in community life, providing vital spiritual comfort and guidance as well as serving as a venue for weddings, funerals, suppers and special events. Some small churches have since closed, but many are still in use. On Saturday, August 25, from noon to 3:30 p.m., eight historic churches from Cumberland to DeSable will open their doors to the public. Visitors will have an opportunity to go inside, ask questions, and admire the ingenuity and craftsmanship of early Islanders. Tea and cookies will be served at Long Creek Baptist Church.
