As in the past with previous CY (now known as uplift) gatherings, there will be three streams at the conference: Youth (ages 14-18), Young Adults (ages 18-25) and Leadership (ages 18+). Each stream will focus on that group's unique needs and faith expression, exploring Audacious Hope through activities, learning, worship, prayer, relationship building and fun. The whole gathering will worship, play, and dine together.

### Synod Council has approved the financial support for any youth in the Synod wishing to attend this year's UPLIFT. They will cover the registration fee of \$635 for any qualifying attendee.

#### **Baby Needs Collection**

Once again this year, the Kirk will be supporting the Island Pregnancy Centre's baby needs baskets for at-risk mothers. You are invited to donate baby needs like: clothing, baby blankets, wash cloths, bath toiletries, diapers, soothers, board books, and plush toys. We will be starting



the collection on Sunday, April 28 and concluding on Mother's Day, May 12. Our collection will be supplemented by goods purchased with a \$1,000 donation from the Atlantic Synod Mission Fund. A box to collect donations will be placed at the Pownal Street entrance. Last year we were able to provide supplies for about 25 baskets of goods for new mothers who lack social supports.
