After Susheela Devi's husband died, she struggled to support her four daughters while running a small cosmetic shop. To ease her financial burdens, two of her daughters were forced into early marriage, and one tragically died during childbirth. With insufficient government aid, her remaining daughters dropped out of school. Through the Karuna Project in India, PWS&D provided resources to help Susheela revive her business and educated her on the dangers of child marriage, prompting her to re-enroll her daughters in school and invest in their futures.
