Developing Spiritually Alive Churches Course

The Center for Missional Leadership is offering a course next year on developing spiritually alive churches and inviting groups of three to ten people from different churches to take part. I (Rev. Amanda) am interested in taking this course and seeing how it may complement and help us continue the ministry and mission we do as a church. I wanted to put this out there to see if there might be a couple of people (or more - we can fit up to ten) interested in taking this course with me. There is no cost for people who would like to take it (churches pay a standard \$400 dollar fee and it covers all participants from that church). If you would like to be part of this please let Rev. The course will be online via Zoom and consists of 5 educational sessions to encourage creative reimagining of how our churches gather and engage their neighbors and 4 coaching sessions with a member of the CML network. They will be held on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. pacific on September 26, 2026 November 28, 2026, January 23, 2027, March 27, 2027 and April 24, 2027.
